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Coronavirus Standards Working Group Meeting Summary

Thanks to all for our meeting Friday 5 March — Heinz Zeichhardt, Martin Kammel, and Hans-Peter Grunert of INSTAND presented a summary of 3 recent EQA Schemes for Anti-SARS-CoV-2 measurements. The work Heinz presented laid out some of the challenges of developing reference samples for serology when compared to direct virus detection -- there are strong effects arising from the plasma samples, and in these studies using unpooled samples, those effects are confounded with time course post-infection, target, assay-assay, and lab-lab performance. This experience will inform both design and analysis of our upcoming serology harmonization study. It will be essential to keep our focus on the study objective to harmonize calibration and control reagents, or we risk creating a complex and ponderous study!
